

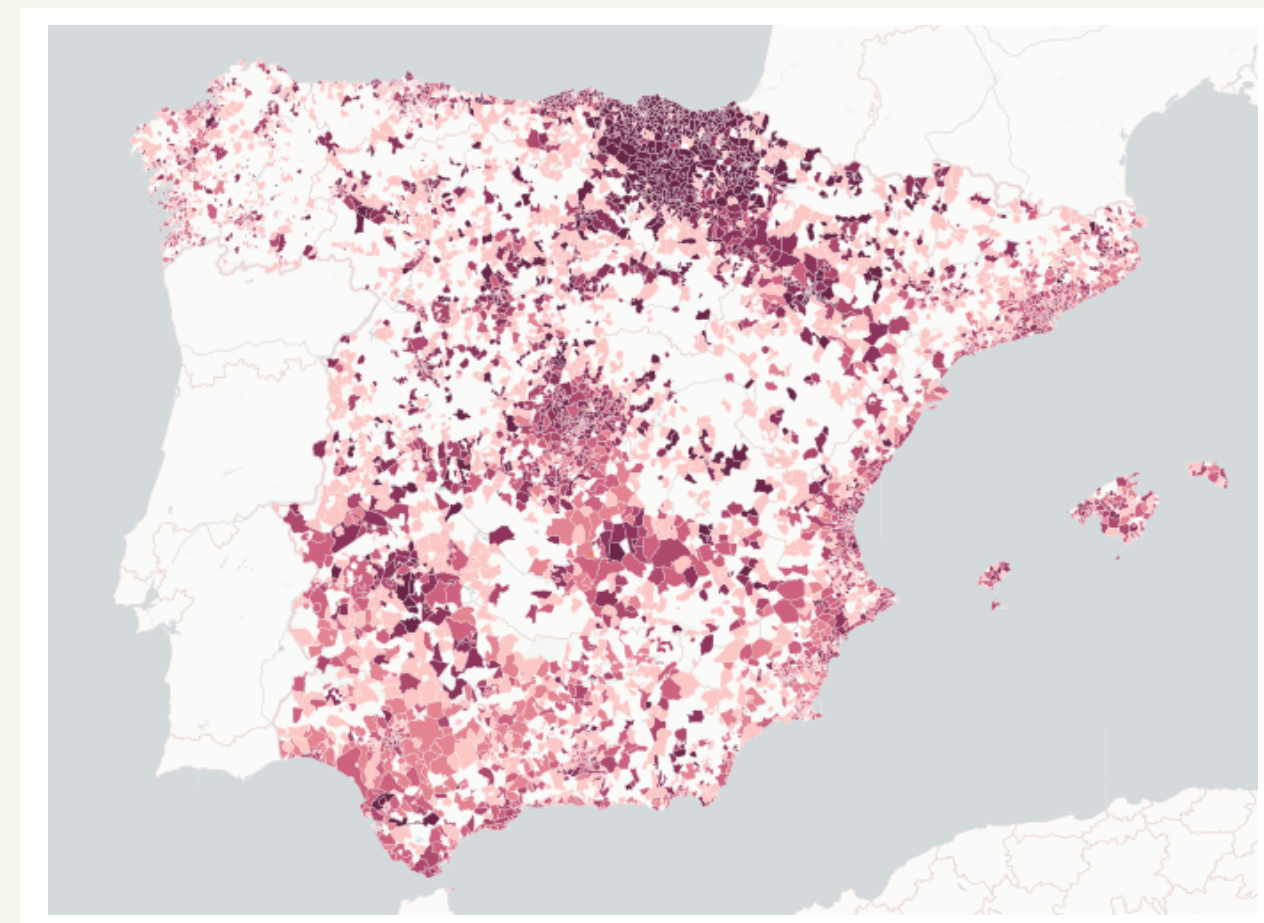

What Are We Doing?

We are estimating the amount of Covid-19 symptomatic cases and getting to know their space and time distribution, to contribute to the knowledge of the pandemic and to facilitate decision making in terms of public health.(Knowing the three fundamental milestones of epidemiology: Place, Time, Person).

- Facilitating this tool and its database to public health authorities, health agencies, health systems, universities and research groups, bearing in mind the impossibility of identifying individuals who answer the surveys, thus guaranteeing confidentiality, privacy and respecting bioethic research principles.
- Establishing own research lines leaving the door open to collaboration with national and international renowned entities in the field.
- Creating a collaborative Create Commons environment, an intervention tool in Public Health through social media.



Who are We?

A growing group of health, IT, social media, entrepreneurs, and self-employed professionals dedicating their free time to this project.

We are working within the existing structure of Fundacion iO, a non-profit organisation trying to slow down the pandemic by enabling processing and graphic representation of data collected from the survey.

Why?

We think this is the most accurate and fastest way to obtain useful data. It is easy to implement and results could be obtained in a matter of hours or days.

How Are We Doing It?

We are conducting an online survey to obtain anonymous information from individuals who are showing and not showing symptoms that are compatible with Covid-19. Anonymous data includes age, gender and geographical location. A form is being distributed accross social media to do the survey.

Do We Seek Any Profit?

Absolutely not. We are volunteers. Our goal is to contribute to scientific knowledge. We are sharing the results of the survey and our working practice with any interested health institution, public health system, universities and research groups for free. Our only interest is the **common good**.

Why Do We Do It?

We want to facilitate containment actions, planification, and any other public health measure that contributes to fighting the Covid-19 pandemic in Spain or beyond if requested.

What Relationship Do We Have With Public Health?

Many of us are health professionals who work in the public and private health systems.

Do We Intend to Replace The Work Of Other Institutions?

No. Our aim is to support their work. We think that this idea, born within the scope of a nonprofit Foundation, can be shared at no cost with those institutions that consider this tool useful. A huge thanks to all of you. We remain at your entire disposal for any questions.
